## Resources to include

### Communication, Language and Literacy

Listen with enjoyment and respond to stories, songs, rhymes and poems and make up own stories, songs, rhymes and poems

Explore and experiment with sounds, words and texts

Read a range of familiar and common words and simple sentences independently

Know that print carries meaning and in English, is read from left to right and top to bottom

Show an understanding of the elements of stories, such as main character, sequence of events, how information can be found in non-fiction texts



### Creative Development

Use their imagination in imaginative play and role-play and stories



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Maintain attention, concentrate and sit quietly when appropriate

Select and use activities and resources independently

Work as part of a group or class, taking turns and sharing fairly



### Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Ask questions about why things happen and how things work
