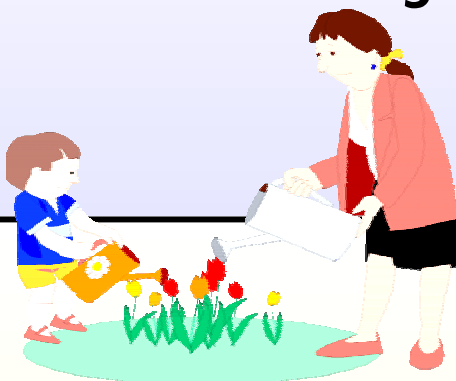


They're

E.g.

They're watering the flowers.

instead of

They are watering the flowers.

Their

‘Their’ is word to use when something belongs to, or is associated with, someone or several people.

E.g.



Their dad pulled them along on their sleigh.

There

‘There’ is used in two ways:

* To indicate a place

E.g. The swing is over **there**.



* As a statement

E.g. **There** are two wheels on my bicycle.
